#### Frequently Asked Questions

When will I hear from my child's coach? The coaches will receive their rosters on March 31. You should receive a call / email from your child's coach by April 1. If you do not hear from them by this time, call Donner Center at (812) 376- 2680.

Can my child change teams if he/she cannot make a practice?
Unfortunately, no. We instead require coaches not to cut a child's playing time simply because they are unable to attend practice.

What if I have a problem?
