



COLUMBUS PARKS & RECREATION DEPARTMENT **CORNHOLE RULES**

SECTION 1 - REGISTRATION AND ROSTERS

- Registration is taken at Donner Center in person or by phone or email (parks@columbus.in.gov) using MasterCard or Visa. No registration will be accepted after the registration deadline.
- To register, a team roster must be submitted at the time of registration. Teams must sign a minimum of two (2) players to their roster and a maximum of three (3). Changes may be made to the roster up to the third match. All names must have complete addresses, phone number and email address.
- All fees must be turned in at the time of registration.

SECTION 2 - ELIGIBILITY

- Participants in the Columbus Parks and Recreation Cornhole Leagues must be 21 years of age or older.
- Players may participate on only one co-ed team per night.
- Teams discovered playing with ineligible players not listed on their roster must forfeit all games played up to that point, whether the ineligible players played in previous games or not.
- Upon request by a supervisor, players must furnish adequate I.D. to verify rosters. Lack of I.D. may result in player's ineligibility until furnished.

SECTION 3 - THE GAME

- The line to throw is the front edge of the board
- Bags CANNOT bounce onto the board. Any bag that has rolled or bounced onto the board should be immediately removed so it doesn't interfere with additional throws.
- Each matchup will consist of a "best of 3" games format. The winner will have won at least "2" of the 3 games played.
- Games are played to 21 using cancellation scoring:
 - 3 points for every bag in the hole
 - 1 point for every bag on the board

- First team to 21+ wins
 - NO penalty for going “over 21”
- “Final Toss” due to time constraints, if the League Supervisor requests a “Final Toss” each player will get 1 more round of throws. The score closest to 21 at the end of the “Final Toss” will determine the winner.

SECTION 4 – END OF SEASON SINGLE ELIMINATION TOURNAMENT

- Tournament seeding will be determined by win/loss record. All teams will qualify for the end-of-season tournament.
- Tiebreakers will be first determined by head to head matchup results. Second tiebreaker will be determined by coin toss.
- Tournament games will follow the same rules as the regular season. However, there will be no “Final Toss.”
