# **Frequently Asked Questions**

#### What Division will my child be in?

The aging date that we will use is 7/31/2025. Your child's age on that day will determine their division.

Example: If your child's birthday is 8/15/2015 they will play in the U10 (under 10) age group. Although they are 10 when the league starts, they were not 10 on the cut-off date. All children must be 4 by 7/31/2025.

# When are the games played and how long is the season?

Games are played on Saturday mornings at 8:30, 10, and 11:30 at Blackwell Park, behind Parkside School. There are six games beginning on August 9 and ending on September 13.

#### When will I hear from my child's coach?

The coaches will receive their rosters prior to July 18. You should receive a call or email from your child's coach by July 18. If you do not hear from them by this time, call Columbus Parks and Recreation at 812-376-2680.

### What about practice?

Teams will be scheduled for 1-2 practices weekly. The coach will determine the day/time and contact you with the information.

#### What happens if games are cancelled?

If the weather is questionable, check the Remind app and the Columbus Parks and Recreation Facebook page. Make up games will be played the next day (Sunday) starting at 1pm. Make sure to check the Remind app for game times. **Please sign up for Remind updates by using code** 87f9hb6

#### My child has a schedule conflict; can they change

**teams?** Due to the size of our soccer program, we cannot accommodate team change requests. We instead require coaches not to cut a child's playing time simply because they are unable to attend practice.

#### **Does Parks provide uniforms?**

Yes! For the safety of all players, players cannot have beads or hard objects in their hair and jewelry (including earrings) is not permitted. New piercings cannot be covered with tape.

Each soccer season over 1,100 Columbus youth participate in the Parks and Recreation soccer program. That is over 100 individual teams that need coaches. Although our program has grown, the number of volunteers has not always kept up, so we ask you to please consider coaching a team (training available)!

## **Background Check & Code of Conduct**
