## Frequently Asked Questions

- **How long is the season?**

There are six games beginning on May 24 and ending June 28.

- **Where are games played?**

Games are played on Saturday mornings at 9 or 10am at Blackwell Park.

- **What about practices?**

Teams will be scheduled for 1-2 practices a week. The coach will determine the day/time and contact you with information.

- **What about gear?**

Parks and Recreation will give each player a shirt and flag belt. All players must provide their own shorts/sweat pants. Mouth guards and cleats are optional and are the player's responsibility.
